

Newspaper Tunnel

Step 1: Lay out a row of sheets of newspaper, overlapping each sheet by approximately a third.



Step 2: Roll the paper around something round.



Step 3: Roll over the ends to stop the tunnel from unraveling. Fold outwards, like turning up trousers. You only need to fold over about an inch, do it twice to keep it secure.



Stick Monster Rabbit Toy

Step 1: Gather a selection of sticks (apple, raspberry, willow) and have them inspected by your bunny assistant.



Step 2: Cut a cardboard tube with scissors to make small holes for the sticks.



Step 3: Poke sticks through the holes. Some can go through only one hole, and others can go in on one side and out through the other side.



Step 4: Give to your bunny for testing.

Bunny Treat Ball



Step 1: Begin with a cardboard tube.

Step 2: With scissors, cut the tube into rings.



Step 3: Push one ring on top of the other to make a small ball.

Step 4: Fill the ball with hay and a small treat.



Step 5: Bunny taste test!



Bunny Treat Bag



Step 1: You will need a paper lunch bag, some hay, some pellets or treats, and some twigs (willow, apple, pear).



Step 2: Cut some holes in the paper bag with scissors.



Step 3: Fill the paper bag about halfway up with hay. Sprinkle in a treat or two, and top off with some twigs.



Step 4: Twist the top of the bag closed. You are done!
